1964 Flood

1964: Disastrous flood damages roads, trails, and buildings in Glacier National Park

US Congress passes the Wilderness Act



Logan Pass Visitor Center, 1966

1965: St. Mary Visitor Center is completed

1966: Logan Pass Visitor Center is dedicated



Granite Park Chalet closure, 1967

1967: Night of the Grizzlies- two women were killed in two different locations (Granite Park campground and Trout Lake Campground)

1968: Glacier adopts Starker Leopold Report's recommendation to restore flora and fauna to represent a vignette of primitive America
