## **Submissions Needed for Glacier National Park Commemorative Book**

**December 8, 2009—Glacier National Park**—To help commemorate the Glacier National Park Centennial in 2010, the Centennial Program is calling for experiential short stories about the park to be published in a book.

“We are looking for stories that reflect experiences and revive memories that people have had with Glacier National Park to celebrate the upcoming centennial,” said Wendy Hill, Executive Director of the Glacier Association.

The committee is hosting an open call for entries by amateur and established writers, ranging from short haikus to stories 2,000 words in length.

Entries may be submitted by email to [kassandra\\_hardy@nps.gov](mailto:kassandra_hardy@nps.gov) through March 1, 2009. There is no entry fee to submit stories. Of the entries received, 100 will be selected and published in a book to benefit the Centennial Program.

Glacier National Park is quickly approaching its 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The park has empowered a team of volunteers to help plan and implement a community-based Centennial Program to take place throughout the latter half of 2009 and run through the celebration year of 2010.
