WEST GLACIER, MT – Glacier National Park officials announce the launch of a website about the 2010 Glacier National Park Centennial.

The site, [www.glaciercentennial.org](http://www.glaciercentennial.org), includes information about the purpose and vision for the celebration, a video clip, and a way to contact event planners. It will be revised regularly to include updates and opportunities for public involvement as they develop.

A series of listening sessions will be hosted throughout the next year to capture comments that will help shape the anniversary celebration. Further details will be posted on the website.
